We ask you to support access to CGMS and fGMS technology by requesting HZZO to add it to their national insurer list.

Advanced countries and national health insurers increasingly recognize the importance and value of painless, continuous glucose measurement in order for people with diabetes to live a healthy and successful life. Citizens of the Republic of Croatia, equal members of the European Union, feel that we have the right to be among the first, and not among the last, to have this revolutionary technology on the national insurer list (reimbursement).
